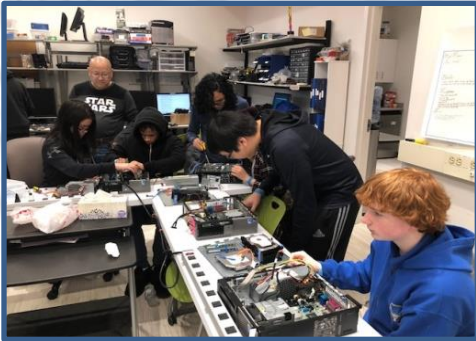

The Square Tech Training Program is offering a volunteer internship that recruits High School youth between ages of 14 – 19. This tech-based youth training program engineers a foundation of learning and developing skills through a series of technology and business based training workshops.

Our young volunteer training interns are learning skills to become successful in the technology field while building lasting friendships with their peers and adults. Training interns are learning the necessary skills to become successful, thriving members of society. Interns receive a learning stipend for participating in the training internship.

Internship: Is 6 weeks long, Monday-Friday 11 am - 4pm with 1 hour break Starts 7/06/21 Ends 8/13/2021.

Volunteer Interns will:

- * Receive a learning stipend while obtaining new technical skills.
- * Undergo workshops and hands-on training that covers the fundamental knowledge and concepts of jobs in the entry-level IT fields.
- * Create story games using Ren'Py which is a visual novel engine, create a controller and create a game using Makey Makey, Create games via coding by using RPG Maker VX Ace, create an app with App Inventor and learn how a business runs through business management.
- * Build their workforce skills.
- * Apply their IT skills.
- * Gain experience in technology
- * Choose 3 workshops based on their IT interests.
